## FASTING & ABSTINENCE

The current Law of the Church (hence that which binds under pain of sin):

That all Fridays throughout the year and the time of Lent are penitential times.

All adults (those 18 years old and older) are bound by law to Fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, until the beginning of their 60th year.

All persons who have completed their fourteenth year are bound by the law of Abstinence on all Fridays.

As Traditional Catholics we wish to follow the traditional mind of the Church in her morals and discipline and not the relaxed spirit promoted by the modern Church. Keep in mind however that to only follow the current laws as they are stated above does not constitute a sin. It is thus simply a question of generosity.

Traditionally, in addition to abstinence from meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays, Catholics would maintain a fast on all Lenten days.

A fast was understood to permit only one full meal with meat (excluding Ash Wednesday and all Fridays). In addition, two small snacks, not equaling a full meal, were permitted to maintain one's strength.

The obligation to fast ceased then, as now, at age 60.

Sunday there is no obligation to fast or abstain.

Persons doing hard physical labor, and those ill, may ask the priest for permission to be released from their fasting obligation.
